

Lavish Scarf

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Fibers

- 1 ball Trendsetter Dune (shown #30) (MC)
- 7 yds of 7/16" Hanah Hand Dyed Silk Ribbon (shown Alpine Flower) (AC)

Needles

- US 13 (9 mm)

Pattern

Using MC CO 11 sts.

K1, * YO, K2TOG, K2, repeat from *, ending with K2TOG

Repeat the above pattern for every row until you have approximately 24 inches remaining, then BO.

Next, weave AC through the openwork on each side of the scarf, leaving one "X" on each side of the ribbon. Then fringe with the remaining ribbon.



Here is this luxurious mohair, silk and metallic scarf that is not only gorgeous, but affordable as well!



Above, are closer looks at the scarf before (left) and after (right) weaving in the silk ribbon.

Tips

- If you are new to openwork designs, practice this pattern on a smoother yarn to get a feel for the pattern first.
- Treat the sides of the ribbon with a light coat of Fray-Chek™ to prevent it from getting ragged from weaving through the slightly snaggy Dune.
- Use a dental floss threader to act as a needle and make the weaving process swifter.



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
